The centre will call clients to arrange a re-booking once it reopens. Services will resume if the Warning / Signal is canceled at or before 2 p.m. 	
	Hoisted during office hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any medical examinations, doctor consultations and support group services in progress will continue. Services that are yet to commence will be cancelled. The centre will call clients to arrange a re-booking once it reopens. HKBCF retains the right to make the final decision. You are welcome to call should you have enquiries 	
	Canceled at or before 2 p.m.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Services will resume two hours after cancellation of the Warning / Signal. Doctor consultation and support services will resume two hours after cancellation of the Warning / Signal. Rebooking can be facilitated based on individual requirements. Rescheduling might be necessary. The centre will advise arrangements for services including mammogram, ultrasound scan and doctor consultation when the centre reopens.
