基金會近日收到不同人士通知，指收到以錄音形式發出聲稱來自不同醫療相關機構的電話，要求他們按指示提供個人資料以領取文件。

基金會重申，基金會如需要聯絡病人，一般透過職員親自致電病人，並會提供相關資料以供核實雙方的身份。基金會再次提醒市民不要向來歷不明的來電提供任何個人資料，如接到懷疑詐騙電話應向警方求助。

The Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation (HKBCF) reminded members of the public again to stay alert to fraudulent calls.

It has been brought to the attention of the HKBCF that certain members of the public received calls in which the caller, in a pre-recorded message, claimed him/herself to be a member of a medical-related organisation and required the call recipient to provide its personal information in order to collect a document.

The HKBCF reiterates that if necessary, the HKBCF will contact its members only through its staff and never on pre-recorded messages. Its staff will also provide relevant information to verify the identity of both the parties. Members of the public are advised not to disclose personal information when speaking to an unidentified caller, and report any suspected fraudulent calls to the Police.
