The Hong Kong Breast Cancer Foundation (HKBCF) was set up on 8 March 2005, as a non-profit charitable organization dedicated to eliminating the threat of breast cancer to the local community through education, support and research and advocacy. Breast cancer is the most common cancer for women in Hong Kong. 1 in every 16 women in Hong Kong gets breast cancer in her lifetime.
